



STUDENT SPOTLIGHT: Brooke Campbell



ACADEMIC PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT: Early Assurance Pathway Programs



The Early Assurance Pathway (**EAP**) is a partnership pathway between The University of Akron and Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) and Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine (LECOM) to educate future health care professionals, offering a leg up when seeking admission to medical school alongside thousands of other pre-health students.

- [Our program is ranked #15 in the country for an affordable pre-med degree.](#)

- Admission to professional school is extremely competitive with acceptance rates of 40% for programs like medical school. Admission to NEOMED EAP is 83%.

- **Each year up to 25 UA sophomores** can be admitted to the EAP, allowing UA students to secure a spot, early, in a future medical school class at NEOMED.

- **Each year up to 5 UA students** can be admitted into LECOM's College of Osteopathic Medicine, School of Dental Medicine, or School of Pharmacy.

Buchtel College students host exonerated men to campus, secure for them full 4-year UA scholarships

Students from the UA chapter of the Ohio Innocence Project (UA-OIP) – pictured from left, **Jess Hess** (Warren, Ohio), treasurer; **Gil Kalina-Hammond** (Painesville, Ohio), vice president; **Megan Wilson** (Mentor, Ohio), president – the Sociology Club and the Criminal Justice Association welcomed Michael Sutton and Kenny Phillips to campus on March 1 to speak about their wrongful imprisonment cases.

It meant so much to hear their stories that, after the event, the students wanted to do more for the men.

Upon learning that Michael Sutton was wrongfully arrested for attempted murder the same day he got a full scholarship letter from The University of Akron, they approached UA President Gary L. Miller with the idea to offer them with this second chance - full tuition and fee scholarships at UA, which were awarded to both Sutton and Phillips on March 10.




