Prior to arriving for your test:

- Check the beginning and end date and time of your test.
- Check the dates and hours for the testing lab. Remember: the posted hours for the testing lab indicate the times during which you may **begin** a test.
- Be sure that you have your ZipCard and that the name and photo on the ZipCard is completely legible.

Taking tests in SHN 152...

The posted hours for the testing lab indicate the times during which you may **begin** a test. Upon entering SHN 152, proceed to the release desk and present your UA ZipCard. At that time, you will be assigned to a computer seat for testing (***you will not be permitted to select your own seat for testing***) and given any materials required for your test. Proceed to the testing lab to your assigned computer. Once seated, select the desired test system and begin your test. If you need further assistance raise your hand and a testing proctor will assist you. To ensure the best possible testing environment please respect others taking tests by remaining quiet as you enter SHN 152, during your test, and anytime you are in the testing lab area / hallway. Violation of testing lab policies, cheating or attempts to cheat will be reported as academic misconduct to UA officials.
