Course Name: Fire Sprinkler System Design
Course Number: FIRE:206
Course Credit: 3 credit hours
Pre-requisites: None

Course Description

This course will cover and review the design, installation and operation of automatic fire suppression systems. Included in the program are automatic sprinklers, ultra speed sprinklers spray systems and water mist systems.

Program Outcomes

Upon completion of this course the student will:

1. Be familiar with the advantages, disadvantages and limitations of various water-based fire suppression systems
2. Apply appropriate NFPA standards and other recognized standards to a given hazard
3. Evaluate a designated structure to identify relevant hazards
4. Demonstrate knowledge of water-based suppression systems including automatic sprinkler and water mist systems.

Assessment:

At the beginning of the semester, the instructor will discuss the format used to evaluate student performance and progress .The criteria for assigning a course grade shall also be discussed. A hard copy and electronic copy of the course syllabus will be provided on Springboard. Assessment methods may include one or more of the following: research papers, book and journal article reviews, written and oral reports, table top exercises, community service projects, and classroom presentations, to be determined by the instructor.
