

Adult Focus Checklist (Returning Students)

Adult Focus Advising Appointment includes:

Academic

- ◇ Determine academic status (i.e probation, dismissal) and obtain Student ID number.
- ◇ Determine last date of attendance
- ◇ Complete Undergraduate Re-enrollment form
- ◇ Review any previous coursework and academic options
- ◇ Discuss career objectives / major (Do I need to visit the Career Center, Student Union 211?)
- ◇ Obtain UANet ID and password (call 330-972-6888)
- ◇ Determine if placement tests are needed
 - Arrange to take placement tests at the Computer Based Testing Center, located in Schrank Hall North 152. Website is www.uakron.edu/testing
- ◇ Make another advising appointment with Adult Focus to:
 - Discuss placement test scores and options
 - Schedule classes for the next term
 - Learn My Akron, Springboard (online learning platform)
- ◇ Visit Zip Card Office for Student ID Card (must bring a copy of your Class Schedule)
- ◇ Veteran Students: Meet with Military Services Center to apply for VA benefits and to learn about services (330-972-7838 or www.uakron.edu/veterans)

Financial

- ◇ Determine financial standing
- ◇ Student needs to complete FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov (UA code: 003123)
- ◇ Explain SAR Report
- ◇ Explain Master Institutional Aid Application
- ◇ Explain “My Akron” regarding Accepting or Declining Award
- ◇ Checking the status of your Financial Aid
- ◇ Explain what to do when student receives aid (what happens next?)
- ◇ Explain Refund Policy
- ◇ Explain keeping your Aid
