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General Discussion

- Committee reviewed Space Allocation request for ASEC 2225 to turn a file room into an office. Lisa Sabol made a motion to approve the request, seconded by Blake Smith. Motion passed unanimously.
- Committee reviewed Space Allocation request for Zook OLS to move staff from a smaller office area to the larger suite nearby where other staff are located. Per Stephen Myers, if approved, it will be for a temporary time and not meant as a permanent solution, as the suite is too big for their group. Joseph Shannon motioned to approve as submitted, Deborah Owens seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.
- Updates from Stephen Myers:
 - Furniture ordered for ASEC
 - Construction began at McClain Gallery
 - Renovation of Akron Polymer Training Center – the design phase should finish soon; construction projected for the fall 2022 semester; opening fall 2023
 - Fire alarm project – Olin, Bierce, CBA – initial bids were rejected and re-opening new bids soon. Bierce Library will be able to use the speaker system to inform guests to leave when closing, fire drills, etc.
 - Interviewed and hired contractors to renovate blue gym in the Rec Center for the basketball practice facility; contracts to go to state for approval
 - Classroom furniture project – all ordered and waiting for it to be manufactured and estimated to be delivered by summer. Most are tablet arm chairs to maintain classroom occupancy numbers
 - Crouse/Ayer construction is on track – labor & materials availability are affected. Estimated completion is January 2023
 - Infocision Stadium turf replacement – opened bids yesterday, should be awarding soon
 - Lee Jackson field track renovation – initial bids were rejected, will put out for a re-bid
 - Vivarium Project – progressing but hit with delay issues due to materials being backordered.
 - Damper replacement project is progressing without delays
 - Camera project construction in parking decks has started
 - Electrical infrastructure project – next phase starting up
 - Signage replacement – many signs that need replaced across campus will be completed soon
 - JAR window needs replaced and just opened bids; lights around JAR are getting replaced as well
 - Polsky Art Center – impacted by construction costs; need to redo scope of project to fit available funding
 - The Summit Metroparks have received bids for next phase of freedom trail, with construction beginning in April, to be completed by end of August. Riders will be able to bike from UA to Kent

- Akron finishing designs for Lock 3 major renovation
- Akron Civic Theater will build a deck that overlooks Lock 3 and a large screen that shows events happening
- EJ Thomas – although there are many needs at E.J., there are funds to upgrade the concessions stand and to improve accessibility.
- Owners of Depot are a Miami based place – going out to bids starting at \$7mil (check article in ABJ)
- Campus safety walk on March 31st – Will start at Bierce Library. Shawn will send info out once specific time is set to ask for volunteers.
- Malik brought up discussion regarding accessibility on campus and issues in certain areas, particularly the Rec Center
