- Called to order – 11:05
- Minutes and agenda approved
- Discussion of concern about accessibility of UA's course offerings on website and Stellic
 - o Jordan Renna- Registrar's office is short-staffed, Stellic being difficult due to the disconnect between it and Workday; priority is probably on getting current students registered
 - o Stacia Biddle- Don't think it's fair to make excuses to students as to why its so hard to register
 - o Dorothy Gruich- are there expectations for deans/departments for making course offerings available
 - o Dean Friesner- could bring this to full UC meeting to bring its attention to the president or others in that group that pertain
 - o Lori Kidd– did workday tutorials, but would like to see the student side
 - o Adara Turek- hard to figure out workday, figure out how to pay my bill
 - o Makayla Minard – when problems were happening – was told not to bother calling financial aid/advising because they were already aware and swamped with other students
- Dr Messina – want to set up a walk-through of the student onboarding process with the whole group
 - o Discussed the disconnect between what's happening on the student services/experience side and what faculty is aware of. Digest could relay announcements.
 - o Looking at what's wrong and what's right in the onboarding process.
 - o At the end of this, maybe talk about highlighting great student experiences.
- Goal 2 – Faculty Brightspace usage
 - o Dr Messina- Could get data on it, might be better to chase the incidents first, then use that to justify requesting the data
 - o Stacia – often helps part-time/new faculty to set up their pages or direct them to IT for assistance, I hope other faculty will do that as well.
- Dr Messina- The childcare program is going well – we have some donors and funding available through Zipassist. Up to 75% of childcare expenses for multiple children through the Y
